INFLUENCE OF USING THE ZOOM MEETING AND WHATSAPP IN LEARNING PROCESS ON STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

The researcher used the instrument Likert scale agrees and most agree with a total of 88.7 percent, but do not agree with a total of 2.3 percent, and Neutral with a total of 6.8 percent. WhatsApp Likert scale agrees and agrees more with a total of 92.2 percent, not agreeing with 2.3 percent, and Neutral with 4.5 percent. The installment of students on the Likert scale agrees and agrees more with a total of 95.5 percent, does not agree with a total of 2.3 percent, and neutral with a total of 2.3 percent. F-count > F-table (17,174 > 2.83), then H0 rejected and receives H1, which means that there are significant differences in the result of the installment of students by the learning process with online classes using the Zoom Meeting media and WhatsApp media.

In 2019 the world suffered from the COVID-19 pandemic, all activities were halted and Timor-Leste was part of the suffering (Pinto et al., 2020). The government of Timor-Leste, from 2019 to 2021, has already stopped the studies of many Timorese in terms of basic education, secondary and tertiary education lost access opportunities (Subramanian, 2017). (2) Through media technology such as Zoom Meeting, Whatsapp, google classroom, and others (Astuti, 2021).

The Instituto Superior Cristal is part of private institution education. This institution utilized Zoom Meetings and Whatsapp for conducting the distancing process during Pandemic Covid-19. The challenges are a lack of human resources for using this learning technology.

The problems that arise from the previously identified by researchers are (1). The lack of knowledge on the use of Zoom Meeting and Whatsapp in the learning process for student delivery, (2) Electricity continues to die frequently, (3) The internet network is less psychiatric, (4) In remote areas, there is no internet network, (5) Students in many remote areas do not have telephone facilities, laptops, and computers, (6) Many teachers, teachers, and colleagues also don't know how to use the Zoom Meeting and Whatsapp in the learning process (7) There is 40 to 50 minibus limitation when Zoom Meeting is free in the learning process, (8) The capacity to send documents should not exceed 100MB through WhatsApp media (Da Costa et al., 2017).

Student study achievement becomes one of the direct objects of a learning process. Each student is motivated to obtain the optimal result of the study. Academic achievement has been obtained in each learning process. Those students are motivated to grasp optimal academic achievement. Obtaining the best academic achievement becomes the target of the students. In total, the research was attended by students from the Department of Nursing semester IV of the Faculty of Private Health, Cristal, with 44 people distributed according to gender: 36 female respondents had 8 male respondents.
